- 2018 Babich Pinot Gris, Marlborough 36
A full bodied Pinot Gris combines the best of the fruit-forward style of Alsace in France, with the crisp, dry style of Italian Pinot Grigio. The result is a stunning wine delivering juicy stone-fruit, apple and spice flavours. The wine has a soft finish – medium dry in style – courtesy of being partially barrel fermented, and not only is it widely considered one of the best New Zealand Pinot Gris produced in recent years, it's also vegan friendly.
- 2020 Bodegas Castro Martin Albariño Sobre Lias, Rias Baixas 36
Sobre Lias is sourced from the family's El Pazo and Castrelo vineyards within the Val do Salnés sub-region of Rias Baixas. The vineyards sit at an elevation between 160-to-820 feet. his tangy white has a briny, chalky character, with bracing acidity giving a racy edge to the fleshy texture. Assertive, fresh and lively.
- 2012 Bourgogne Aligote, Domaine Potinet Ampeau, Burgundy 40
A subtle touch of matchstick character sits atop the still fresh aromas of pear and various floral elements. There is good volume to the punchy and nicely detailed flavours that possess an appealing richness on the acceptably complex but pleasantly persistent finale.
- 2017 E. Guigal Coindreau, Rhône Valley 55
Whiffs of sun-kissed grain or hay are restrained on the nose, but the palate of these voluminous Viognier bursts of peach, honeysuckle and apricot. It's lavish and textured, with a long, warming finish marked by layers of saffron and candle wax.

Red Wine

- 2017 Teso La Monja Romanico, Toro 35
Deep, shimmering ruby. Highly perfumed cassis, cherry and candied violet aromas, along with suggestions of baking spices and wood smoke that build in the glass. Sweet and penetrating on the palate, offering vibrant, spice-tinged cherry and dark berry flavours given spine by a core of juicy acidity. Shows fine definition and spicy persistence on an impressively long, sappy finish that leaves a sweet blackberry note behind.
- 2010 Lafon de Loup, Bergerac 38
Despite the region's long, varied history, Bergerac wines often play second fiddle to its famed neighbour. Predominantly cabernet sauvignon and merlot the wines tend to be softer, less tannic and much more approachable than its neighbour, Bordeaux.
- 2019 Babich Pinot Noir, Marlborough 42
Dark cherry and Doris plum aromas with mushroom, a hint of strawberry, dried herbs, and cedar notes. Mouth-filling and texturally dense with sweet dark fruits, spice and also bright raspberry notes. The fruit notes are joined by thyme on the lingering finish.
- 2016 Château Clos de Boüard, Montagne Saint-Émilion 58
Medium garnet-purple colored, it leaps from the glass with bold scents of wild blueberries, red currant jelly and plum preserves plus touches of truffles, mossy bark and cinnamon stick. Medium-bodied with great freshness on the palate, it has a taut, muscular core of red and black berry flavors and a chewy frame, finishing with a spicy kick.
- 2009 Gemstone Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Youtville (Magnum) 80
Gemstone's 2009 is bursting with freshly cut flowers, cinnamon, nutmeg, mint, plums, tobacco and dark red cherries. The 2010 captures plenty of the Gemstone silkiness and richness, but it has considerably more finesse in its tannin and far better balance than the Cabernet Sauvignon in this vintage. High-toned floral notes keep the 2009 light on its feet at all times. This is a delicious and subtle wine from Gemstone to savour over the next handful of years. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2025.
